**Deut 6:4** “Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.”

**1Kings 8:60** “... that the LORD is God and that there is no other.”

**Is 45:5** “I am the LORD, and there is no other; apart from me there is no...”

**Is 45:18** “...he says: “I am the LORD, and there is no other.”

**Mark 12:29** ““The most important one,” answered Jesus, “is this: ‘Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one.’”

**Rom 3:29-30** “...Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too, since there is only one God...”

**1Cor 8:4** “...We know that an idol is nothing at all in the world and that there is no God but one.”

**1Tim 2:5** “For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,”

**James 2:19** “You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.”

*The Father is a distinct person of God...*

**Matt 11:25-27** “At that time Jesus said, “I praise you, Father, Lord...”

**Matt 26:39** “...“My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will.””

**John 14:16** “And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever”

**Psa 89:26** “He will call out to me, ‘You are my Father, my God, the Rock my Savior.’”

**Is 63:16** “But you are our Father, though Abraham does not know us or Israel acknowledge us; you, O LORD, are our Father, our Redeemer from of old is your name.”

**Matt 6:9** ““This, then, is how you should pray: ‘Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,’”

**Gal 4:4-6** “But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son...””

*The Holy Spirit is a distinct person of God...*

**Luke 11:13** “...your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!””

**John 14:26** “But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name...”

**John 16:13-14** “But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own...”

**John 15:26** ““When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father...”

**Matt 28:19** “...in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,”

**2Cor 13:14** “May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”

**1Pet 1:1-2** “... the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ...”

**Rom 8:26-27** “In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness...”

**Acts 5:3-4** “Then Peter said, “Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit...”

**1Cor 6:11** “...you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.”

**Matt 12:28** “But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.”

Jesus Christ is a distinct person and God...

**Mark 1:9-11** “At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. As Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: “You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased.””

**John 17:1-5** “After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: “Father, the time has come. Glorify your Son...”

**John 7:39** “Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified...”

**John 16:7** “...Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.”

**Rom 10:9-13** “That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord (κύριος)(kurios),” and believe in your heart that God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos) raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. As the Scripture says, “Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame.” For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord (κύριος)(kurios) of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord (κύριος)(kurios) will be saved.””

**1Cor 12:3** “Therefore I tell you that no one who is speaking by the Spirit of God says, “Jesus be cursed,” and no one can say, “Jesus is Lord,” except by the Holy Spirit.”

**1Cor 16:22-24** “If anyone does not love the Lord—a curse be on him. Come, O Lord ! The grace of the Lord Jesus be with you...”

**1Cor 8:6** “yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.”

**Col 1:15-19** “He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things were created...”

**Col 2:9** “For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form”

**Heb 1:1-3** “...but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God’s glory and the exact representation of his being...”

**John 1:1-3** “In the beginning was the Word (λόγος)(Logos), and the Word (λόγος)(Logos) was with God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos), and the Word (λόγος)(Logos) was God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos). He was with God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos) in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.”

**Heb 1:8-12** “But about the Son he says, “Your throne, O God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos), will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos), your God (ὁ Θεός)(ho theos)...””

**Titus 2:13** “while we wait for the blessed hope—the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ”

**Phil 2:5-7** “Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God...”

**John 20:28** “Thomas said to him, “My Lord and my God!””

**1John 5:20** “We know also that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true—even in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.”
