

## Declaration of Commitment

As a team member of the Philippines 2010 Mission, you will have the opportunity to state “**Declaration of Commitment**” during team training.

In preparing your declaration, you should reflect upon your life and look at what God has uniquely given you to give away to others. Who has the Lord already caused you to be? What can you contribute to the team? What do you hope the results are?

The declaration is a statement of **who you are committed to being** and the **fruit, cause, impact, or relationship you are committed to produce**. It will include **who you declare yourself to be** for your teammates and others and **values** for which you stand for. It reflects your condition, state, mood or way of being. It declares who you are in the uniqueness God has created you to be, **what you value in life**, and defines **how you will stand** in relationship to what you say really matters to you.

**Possibilities:** humility, transparency, intimacy, love, reconciliation, excellence, honesty, organization, unity, order, fun, excitement, truth, encouragement, joy, enthusiasm, purity, service, compassion, trust, worship, perseverance, hope, completion, responsibility, prayer, communication, loyalty, integrity, safety, mercy, peace, patience, loyalty, kindness, faithfulness, understanding, vulnerability...etc.

**Example:** I am committed to mercy by being a focused listener and truly understanding what others feel and experience.

The results will be that others will experience intimacy and compassion.
